### **Fortescue Fields in Norton St Philip Shortlisted Again**

Following hot on the heels of three other national awards and three regional awards, the critically acclaimed development of Fortescue Fields, a joint venture between boutique developers Lochailort Investments and national house builder Bloor Homes, has once again been nominated for a high profile national design award.

The Housing Design Awards, organised by Design for Homes and sponsored by The Department for Communities and Local Government, the RIBA and the Mayor of London to mention a few have selected Fortescue Fields as one of their Shortlisted Schemes for 2016.

Fortescue Fields, designed by [ADAM Architecture](#), stands out in a crowd of predominately modern schemes, principally in urban locations.

Project Director for Lochailort Investments, Jamie Adam added that with very few properties remaining to be sold on the development, there was a limited opportunity for buyers seeking a high quality cottage or apartment. The properties, being marketed through Savills’s Bath office are designed specifically for the over 55’s and have proved popular with second home owners and benefit from an onsite estate manager five days a week and a high quality specification.
